

# PARKING

Dear patients,

Since February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023, the city of Montreal replaced our previous red parking passes by single use parking permits that can be purchased by clients from any Pay and Go station (street parking pay stations).

Here are a few parking options to help you plan your visit to our clinic.

## PAID PARKING



### MUNICIPAL PARKING "PAY AND GO"

- » **4543 Fabre** or **4528 Marquette**. The cost is \$4/hour and easy to access. Please make sure not to park in any spots reserved for monthly permit holders.



### "CLICKNPARK" PARKING SPOTS

- » **1350 Saint-Joseph East**, behind the church, accessible via Lanaudière Street.
- » **4828 de Bordeaux**, behind the church, between Gilford and Saint-Joseph East.

You need to reserve your parking spot ahead of time via the **ClicknPark** app. The cost of a spot may vary throughout the day but will generally be about \$3/hour.



### PARKING METERS

- » On Fabre and Marquette Streets, north of Mont-Royal, or on Mont-Royal, at the cost of \$3.75/hour. Located about 5 minutes away from the clinic by foot.



### DAILY PERMITS

Daily parking permits will allow you to park in areas reserved for residents near the clinic.

You can purchase a daily parking permit from **any of the city of Montreal's Pay and Go station**. There are three Pay and Go stations near the clinic (see the map on the other side):

- » **1351 Laurier East** (in front of the Jean-Coutu)
- » **1835 Laurier Est** (near the convenience store)
- » **4748 de La Roche**

### HOW IT WORKS

- » Go to a Pay and Go station.
- » Enter **PMR02** when asked to enter the parking spot.
- » Follow the payment instructions. The permit costs \$8.
- » Print the receipt and leave it on your dashboard on the side closest to the street.

# FREE PARKING

- » A third of parking spots on the streets near the clinic (Saint-Joseph, Fabre, Marquette, Cartier, Garnier, Gilford, etc.) are free and require no special permits. However, it may be hard to find free parking during busy periods, snow removal periods, or when the streets are being cleaned.
- » A few free parking spots are available on Laurier (one street north of the clinic). You can park in these spots for up to 2 hours.
